5. Special Report: Truckee Canal XM Project and District Irrigation Modernization
On January 5, 2008, the north embankment of the Truckee Canal, at a point
approximately 12 miles downstream of the Derby Diversion Dam, in the City of Fernley
breached after a storm. 590 homes were flooded. As a result of the breach, repairs were
made to the Canal and safety related limitations were imposed upon the use of the Canal
-when diverting water from the Truckee River. Reclamation completed several studies
that identified areas requiring repair and maintenance to address the safety concerns.
Until long-term repairs are made, the Canal is required to operate at a lower stage (water
level) to comply with short-term risk reduction measures.

The District must improve the structural integrity of the Canal to reduce the risk of any future breach of the Canal. Measures, including the lining of a portion of the Canal, must be undertaken so as to provide for safe, long-term operation. This is very important for two reasons: 1. Public Safety; and, 2. Service of the judicially decreed water rights held in the Newlands Federal Reclamation Project. In the simplest terms, an event like that which occurred in 2008 must never happen again. If long-term repairs are not provided for, the consequence will be the reduction of Canal flow to a much lower, safe level.

The cost for long-term repair to the Canal is the responsibility of the District. Repair costs are estimated to be as much as \$35 Million. The District has made application to the federal government for funds with which to effect Canal repair; however, while some portion of the repair costs may be deemed non-reimbursable, the District must provide repayment for any reimbursable portion of the costs. The electors of the District (water users) must approve a contract for repayment to the federal government upon an election.

The District is one of the first Reclamation Projects authorized pursuant to the Reclamation Act of Congress on June 17, 1902. The Newlands Project consists of hundreds of miles of open channel canals, laterals, sub-laterals, and drains —with their associated water control features. Much work is needed to improve the efficiency of Project water conveyance features in order to conserve water for all beneficial uses associated therewith, including agricultural, wildlife, municipal, and others. A study is now underway by the Farmers Conservation Alliance, under contract with Reclamation, to create a modernization plan for the Newlands Project. The plan will guide the District when prioritizing and budgeting for future Project improvements.
