All meetings of the Committee for the Truckee-Carson Irrigation District (TCID or the District) are public (NRS 539.093). This agenda is a tentative meeting schedule. Action will be taken on all items unless otherwise noted. While meetings of the Committee are subject to Nevada Open Meeting Law (NRS 241.010 et. Seq.) (OML), no provision of the OML requires the Committee to discuss or take action on all agenda items. The Committee may hear items in a different order, combine items for consideration or remove an item from the agenda or delay discussion relating to any item at any time to accomplish business of the Committee, on behalf of the electors of TCID,

in the most efficient manner. Items scheduled at a specific time will not be heard earlier than at the scheduled time pursuant to the OML. Except in an emergency, TCID will provide written notice of its meetings consisting of a clear and complete statement of the topics scheduled to be considered. No action may be taken on any matter that is not scheduled on this agenda. Any statement made by a member of TCID during a public meeting is absolutely privileged and does not impose liability for defamation or constitute a ground for recovery in any civil action. Meetings of the Committee may be conducted according to the rules of parliamentary procedure.

The Committee may recess the meeting in order to convene an attorney-client meeting.

The Committee may take possible action on any item on this agenda unless that item is marked "For Information Only." Items marked "For Information Only" may be discussed by the Committee after any presentation is made but no action may be taken on that particular item. Some actions may require Board approval with Committee recommendations.

6. <u>Water Operation Districts and Employee Assignment in the Newlands Federal</u> Reclamation Project

Deliberation and decision by the Employee Relations Committee, upon consultation and discussion with the Truckee-Carson Irrigation District Employee's Association (Association), as to the formulation of recommendations to be made for final approval by the Board of Directors relating to water delivery in the Newlands Federal Reclamation Project in water season 2022, as the same do relate, or may relate, to water operations by the board, management, and staff of the District:

- 1. Development of recommendations relating to the scope of authority by the District Water Master to determine the geographical boundaries of water delivery districts and appropriate employee assignments to be made to reasonably service each water delivery district in the Project;
- 2. Development of a recommended map depicting water delivery districts in the Project;
- 3. Development of recommendations, in consultation made with the Association, relating to water operations assignments in each water delivery district in the Project;
- 4. Development of recommendations, in consultation made with the Association, relating to the qualifications, appointment, and/or manner of assignment of employees necessary to operate each water delivery district, the total number of employees in each district, the total number of employees of all districts, and consideration for the number of employees that will be given positions of permanent employment in the District; and,
- 5. Development of recommendations, to both the board of directors and the Policy Committee, upon consultation made with the Association, relating to provision of a written district policy describing the creation of water operation districts, a map depicting water operation district boundaries, a description of the labor force necessary to sustain proper water delivery in each water delivery district to be created, and the process of preparing for approval of an annual budget relating to water operations in the District.
