No action may be taken on any matter that is not scheduled on this agenda. 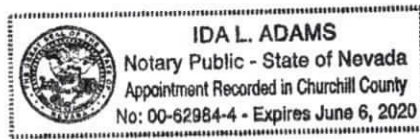
