 Consideration/Possible Action: Formulation of Operational Procedures and Policy for recovery of unpaid costs for placement of new and/or replacement pump suction lines in the Truckee Division of the Newlands Federal Reclamation Project. (See Letter Dated October 20, 2016 stating costs).

Let's also take the issue up with our Finance Committee -Helen-Marie. What I suggest we do with this is to say as a matter of policy:

"The District shall compel water users in the Truckee Division of the Newlands Project, at their own expense, to provide for regulating devices, including, without limitation, any new or replacement pump suction line in accordance with design criteria approved by Reclamation. Upon approval by the O&M Committee, a water user may enter into a repayment plan with the District for the cost of any such device. Failure to provide repayment for a device, or a plan for repayment for the device, will result in suspension of its use. The pump may be removed with or without notice to the water user. (Authority: NRS 539.233 (Regulating and Measuring Devices)).

- 2. <u>Consideration/Possible Action:</u> Review and Amendment to schedule of measurement device installations pursuant to the water measurement plan of the Truckee-Carson Irrigation District -Mike Adams
- 3. Consideration/Possible Action: Reinstallation of Soft Plug at Derby Dam.
- 4. <u>Consideration/Possible Action:</u> Application by NDOW and Waterfowl Association to pursue grant funding for purposes of utilizing the L12 lateral and the newly created channel known as the "Big Dig" as a delivery feature to the Carson Lake Pasture,

5. <u>Consideration/Possible Action</u>: Development of recommendations to the Board of Directors relating to current District operations and operations personnel needs.
