Deliberation and decision relating to approval of a Resolution, No. 2020-5, adopting and ratifying findings and recommendations by the Negotiations Committee, of the District, developed after having conducted multiple joint negotiation sessions with the United States, through the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, relating to a proposal to enter into new contract, to succeed the existing contract, for the operation and maintenance of the Newlands Federal Reclamation Project. The existing Contract will expire the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2021. The Resolution also provides for the scheduling of a special election to be conducted for the benefit of all District electors, as required by NRS 539.297, stating that "[a]ny proposal to enter into a contract with the United States for "the operation and maintenance of existing works . . . must be voted upon at a special election, district election or primary or general state election in the manner provided in the case of the ordinary issuance of district bonds." The Resolution bears, as an exhibit thereto a copy of the proposed new contract and further provides for all other election related matters, including, without limitation, a schedule for the

provision of notices of the election to be given to electors of the District, publication of notices, appointment of election officials, preparation and presentation of absentee ballots, elector registration, and the canvassing of votes.
