6. General Manager & Staff Reports

 Ben Shawcroft, General Manager Shawcroft had no report.

• Cody Biggs, Construction & Maintenance Manager

Biggs reported his crew is working in the Truckee Division to prepare for their season. While the Canal is off, he is completing an RO&M at Painted Rock which consists of a liner repair. In the Carson Division, he has crews working on trouble calls as they come in.

7. <u>Damage Claims Submitted</u>

23-001 Deanna Buff

Damage Claim in the amount of \$55,000.00 for damage caused by a tree falling on their home and property.

This discussion was tabled as no information has been received from the insurance company.

• 23-003 Benjamin Tejeda

Damage Claim in the amount of \$11,180.00 for flood damage to his property at 4411 Bourbon Street, Fallon, Nevada.

This discussion was tabled as the claimant was not present to answer questions.

• 23-004 David Serrahn

Damage Claim in the amount of \$1,500.80 as compensation for water charged to his serial number during water year 2022 that was not received.

David Serrahn provided an overview of his claim to the Committee; he submitted three (3) adjustment requests during water year 2022. His reason for submitting adjustment requests was that the CFS charged was more than his ditch could carry without overtopping. One request was approved, the other two (2) were denied. Mr. Serrahn's argument is that each request was exactly the same and it is illogical to grant one but not the others. He also

argues that because he was shorted water, he had to purchase additional water to irrigate his field. That is the basis of his request for compensation.

District Water Master Herwick commented on the adjustment process last season. Mr. Serrahn's subdivision takeout is directly below a meter, and as his property is in a subdivision the time charged is for the subdivision as a whole. Mr. Serrahn argued that the meter was incorrect as the amount of water charged would overtop the ditch.

The Committee has no history of granting financial compensation for denied adjustment requests in the past and is concerned that granting one now could set a precedent.

A <u>motion</u> was made by Committee Member Gomes to deny Damage Claim 23-004, seconded by Vice-Chairman Oakden, request for comment and the motion was unanimously approved.

Mr. Serrahn informed the Committee that he was going to take some time to consider whether or not he intended to appeal the Committee's decision. He will be in contact within the week to communicate his decision.

Leanna Hale, Land and Water Director, reported that there is a section on the R11 that needs the weeds cleared out. Water orders are starting to slow down.

14. Bureau of Reclamation Representative(s)

Robert Owen, Bureau of Reclamation, reported that his office is dealing with post flood operations. The 3-year RO&M Inspection is scheduled for February 2024. The Tribe's S7-3 Lateral Project is being finalized.
